Y9 History Trip to Krakow – Tuesday 16 July-Thursday 18 July 2024

Thank you for making the final payment for this trip to Krakow. I am delighted to share with you the final information for travel.

Departure from London Gatwick on Tuesday 16 July

We will be flying with **EasyJet 8821** at 09.25 from London Gatwick North Terminal. Students should arrive at the EasyJet departure area of the North Terminal of Gatwick Airport at **07.00** with **one cabin bag measuring no more than 45x36x20cm, which must fit under their seat.** The airline is very strict regarding the size of bags and students will have to pay an additional fee at the gate if their bag does not comply with the required size. Suitable <u>Cabin bags</u> can be found online and in many High Street shops. **An ideal bag to take would be the Newstead Wood School PE bag which is small and soft and easy to squidge into tight spaces.**

Everything your child needs for the trip should fit inside their carry-on cabin bag, please do not bring any additional hand luggage. Any liquids should not exceed 100ml, any liquids exceeding 100ml will be taken by airport staff at security.

Students should arrive with their passport and GHIC card. Please see my earlier email regarding GHIC cards, sent on 23 February 2024.

Itinerary of trip

Wednesday – Arrive Krakow, coach transfer to hostel, followed by a 2-hour guided walking tour of Krakow including the Old Town Square, Wawel Hill and the Cloth Hall. Free time and evening meal.

Thursday – Breakfast followed by coach transfer to Auschwitz memorial Museum for 3.5 hour guided tour. The group will return to Krakow by coach visiting Podgorze (wartime ghetto) and Kazimierz (Jewish District). Students will have free time in Krakow followed by an evening meal.

Friday – Breakfast, check out and transfer to airport for return flight.

Arrival at London Gatwick on Thursday 18 July

Our inbound **EasyJet flight 8822** will arrive at **12.30 GMT on Thursday 18 July.** Please collect your child promptly from the Arrivals Hall.
